# Vaccine Rollout in the Country

- Somalia received vaccine against COVID19 disease on 15<sup>th</sup> of March and Started immediate vaccination from 16<sup>th</sup> in one of the High Risk Administrative region of Banadir followed by all other states in the country.
- The country received 300,000 doses of AstraZeneca Vaccine from COVAX Facility and donated by GAVI through UNICEF and WHO

<b>Total People vaccinated</b>	<b>228,646</b>
<b>First Dose</b>	<b>145,295</b>
<b>Second Dose Completed</b>	<b>83,351</b>

**First dose :** current Number of People who have only received their first dose of the AstraZeneca or Sinopharm vaccine .

**Second dose:** current Number of People who have only received the AstraZeneca and are considered fully immunized.

# State wise number of people completed 1<sup>st</sup> dose by prioritized group

## 1<sup>st</sup> dose - summary Prioritized group

- 22% health care workers vaccinated
- 44% frontline workers received vaccine
- 34 % elderly population received vaccine.

## 2<sup>nd</sup> dose states except Somaliland

- 22 % health care workers vaccinated
- 36 % frontline workers received vaccine
- 42% elderly population received vaccine.

# Challenges

The Dimagi digital data collection was the biggest challenge to handle data management.

Rumors and false beliefs from the vaccine

Poor of Awareness and Health education to the public (Extreme Limit Number of Mobilizers)

lack of operational costs for better vaccination implementation activities contributed the low uptake of vaccine

Lack of logistics and Transports in some districts

Failed to reach large number of people in IDPs, Rural and Villages due to Access Challenge
